

Flush DNS Cache Unbuntu

Introduction

Ubuntu caches DNS queries local. As long as the DNS address of a node does not change, this is very useful. Unless there is a change and the client should react very quickly, you have to flush/delete to cache. This manual describes how to do that.

Method I: Flush the cache

Take a look at the cache:

```
resolvectl statistics
```

Clear the cache:

```
resolvectl flush-caches
```

Method II: Flush the cache

```
systemd-resolve --flush-caches
```

```
systemd-resolve --statistics
```

Method III: Flush the cache

```
killall -USR2 systemd-resolved
```
