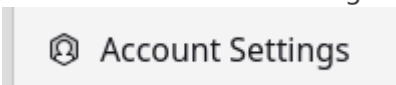

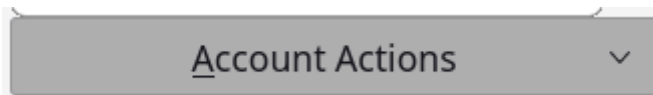
1. Nach dem Start von Thunderbird links unten auf das Einrichtungs-Icon klicken:

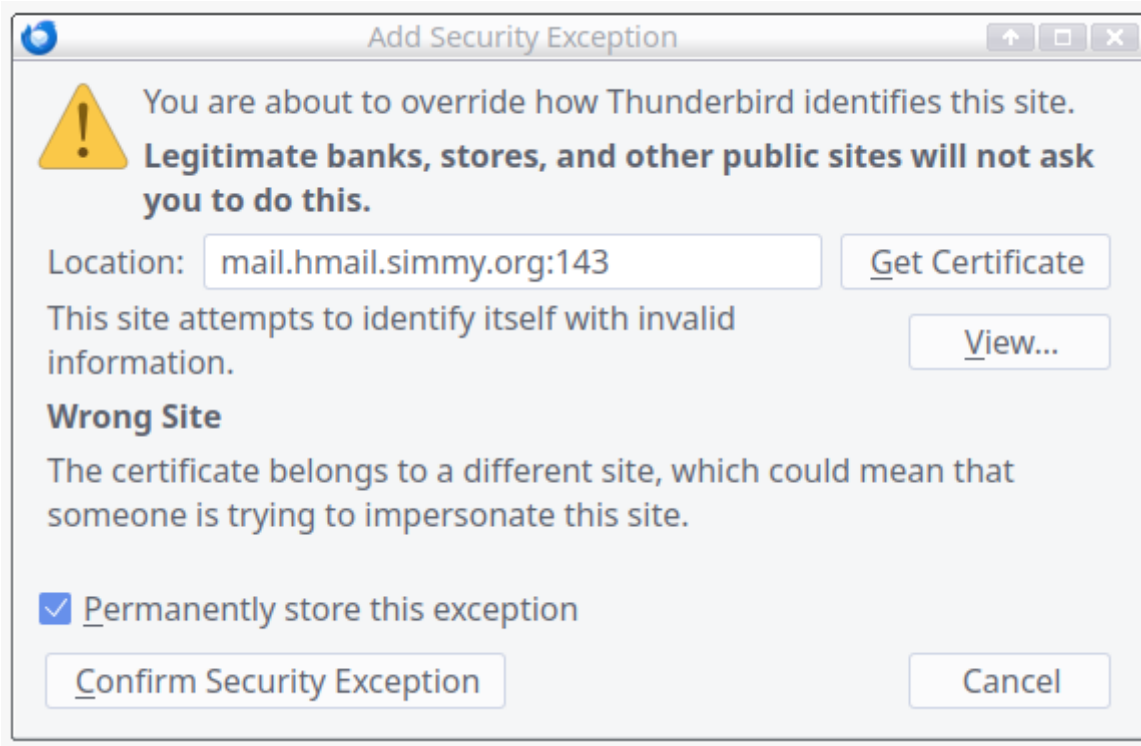
